



**AmA** (pronounced AH-ma) is the Latin root word for love, and is also the name for songstress Amanda Bauman's indie electronica pop project. Based out of Los Angeles, **AmA**'s first album *Electric Life* was released in 2011 on I-tunes. The edgy synth driven song Dispatch was quickly licensed to be the theme song for the gangster parody called *Bullet in the Face*. New York Times review said, "One good thing about *Bullet in the Face*, a new series on IFC, is the theme song..... a spoof of a Goldfinger era, James Bond anthem." **AmA**'s second album *Luminere* will feature more of the danceable electro pop, and is expected to be released in early 2013.
